

**Full Time Informal Educator Position

Overview:

Temple Judea, The San Fernando Valley's largest Reform congregation is looking to add a dynamic, charismatic personality to our Educational team. This person would be responsible to the Director of Education and would direct all of our informal educational and youth programming.

Specific job description:

The annual duties include but are not limited to:

1. Directing Religious School program – grades 7-12
2. Direct our Nisayon – camp style religious school – (includes two weeks in summer – a week in winter – and monthly family programs on Sunday afternoons)
3. Serve as Youth Director – overseeing our four youth groups
4. Serve as Advisor to the Sr. Youth group
5. Co-ordinate our Retreat programs – one 4-7th grade retreat – and one 9-12 high school retreat – on the topic of love, sex and relationships)
6. Co-ordinate a high school trip to the RAC (Religious Action Center) in Wash DC
7. Co-ordinate the Los Angeles - Tel Aviv Partnership Program – and two annual student exchanges – between Temple Judea and Ironi Yud Dalet – (a public Tel Aviv high school)
8. Co-ordinate other trips that may occur (New York, Poland etc.)

Skills needed:

This person must have great people skills – be highly organized – have excellent Judaic programming skills – be able to develop meaningful and enjoyable learning experiences for children and adults – must be charismatic – someone kids enjoy being around, and be a person who enjoys working as part of a creative team where their skills will be valued and their sphere of expertise respected.

The job begins July 1, 2010 and the salary is that of a full time educator on an educational team – and includes benefits.
