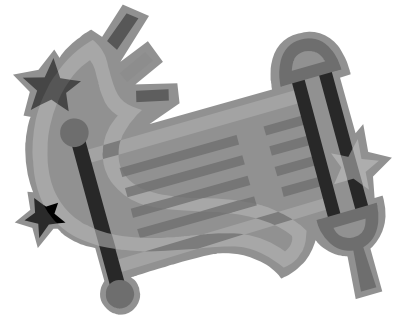




## Fall Holiday Online Resources
